Hazard severity

- 1. Trivial (e.g. discomfort, scratch, slight bruising)
- 2. Minor (e.g. small cut, abrasion, basic first aid needed)
- 3. Moderate (e.g. strain. sprain, incapacity more than 3 days)
- 4. Serious (e.g. fracture, amputation, hospitalised more than 24 hrs)
- 5. Fatal

Rating bands (a x b):

Low risk (1-8): Continue activity but review periodically to ensure controls remain effective

Medium Risk (9-12): Continue activity, but implement additional reasonably practicable controls where possible and monitor regularly

High Risk (15-25): STOP THE ACTIVITY. Identify new controls to reduce risks to medium or low

Likelihood of occurrence

- 1. Remote (almost never)
- 2. Unlikely (occurs rarely)
- 3. Possible (could occur, but uncommon)
- 4. Likely (recurrent but not frequent)
- 5. Very likely (occurs frequently)
